- 5. The fruit of faith costs something. It means that we truly take Jesus at His word. It means that we follow His counsel before all others. Is this true in your life? Please share and discuss.
- 6. Mature faith is growing to look at the world like Jesus. It is living like Jesus. It is becoming like Jesus. What are the main obstacles in your life that make it difficult to become like Jesus? Discuss.
