 4. "Who you are is God's gift to you. Who you become is your gift to God." Look at the person that you are, right now, as you are. Can you see His purpose for you in the gifts and opportunities He has given you? What is one thing you could do today to fulfill that purpose, to invest in those gifts and talents as a gift to Him in response?
 5. Do I struggle with taking initiative, letting myself be challenged, or risking failure when it comes to investing in the talents, gifts, and opportunities I have been given? How so?
