Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever been “left behind” or “lost” when you were a kid? Share the story.
 2. It is one thing to be “left behind”, it is another thing for your absence not to be noticed. Have you ever experienced the pain of feeling overlooked or not noticed? If you don't mind, please share.
 3. The thief who must have been a terrible criminal turned to Jesus with one prayer, “Jesus, remember me”. What do you imagine he saw in Jesus that would lead him to make this request? Do you think that you would be able to pray like that if you were in his position? Why or why not?
 4. Harmony realized the truth that she was loved before she stopped living a life of brokenness. How often do you wrestle with the truth that God loves you first...before you are healed and before you stop sinful behavior? Is that truth easy to believe and accept or is it difficult? Please share.
 5. Jesus reveals that He is a king who notices, loves, and remembers us in the midst of our feeling forsaken and forgotten. Can you accept that truth, or is that a challenge for you? Please discuss and share.
