 4. The saliva mixed with dust that Jesus placed on the blind man's eyes worked to undo what had come undone through Adam (formed out of the dust of the earth.) What about this strikes you?
 5. In a world come undone, the biggest thing that has come undone is our trust of God. Has your trust in God come undone? If so, how so? If not, what has helped keep you grounded in trusting Him? Please share, encouraging one another.
