- 3. Have you ever thought about your having a home in the Father's Heart? There may be seasons where you may find yourself in exile, away from home. But what is it about that home that makes you want to stay there, or return back to it?
- 4. In the Gospel of John Jesus prays, "I pray for them, Father, that the love with which You love Me may be in them." What strikes you about that prayer? Please share.
- 5. You are a temple of His love. Knowing that His love and power and His very self abide in you, how does that change your approach to your day-to-day life? When do you see that love and power most at work?
