- 2. FOR THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL, WHAT BEGAN AS AN EXTERNALLY IMPOSED EXILE BECAME AN INTERNALLY SELF-IMPOSED EXILE: THERE WAS A WAY HOME, AND THEY STAYED AWAY. CAN YOU RELATE TO THEIR EXPERIENCE IN YOUR OWN WALK WITH GOD? HOW SO?
- 3. IN THAT EXILE. WE COULD BE CHOOSING TO HIDE FROM GOD OR WE COULD BE AVOIDING GOD IN THE MIDST OF BUSYNESS. WHICH OF THESE "DEFENSE MECHANISMS" DO YOU FIND YOURSELF USING THE MOST? WHY DO YOU THINK THAT IS?
 - 4."HOW I GOT HERE IS ON ME, AND HOW I GET HOME IS ON HIM." WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO TO GET HOME? WHAT'S YOUR FIRST STEP? HOW WILL YOU TAKE IT?
 - 5. WHEN WE GO TO CONFESSION, WE GIVE IESUS THE PLEASURE OF FULFILLING HIS VOCATION. HOW DOES HIS PERSPECTIVE OF THE SACRAMENT AFFECT HOW YOU APPROACH IT? HOW DO YOU DEAL WITH ANY FEARS OR HESITATIONS YOU HAVE ABOUT IT?
